

Hungry Harry

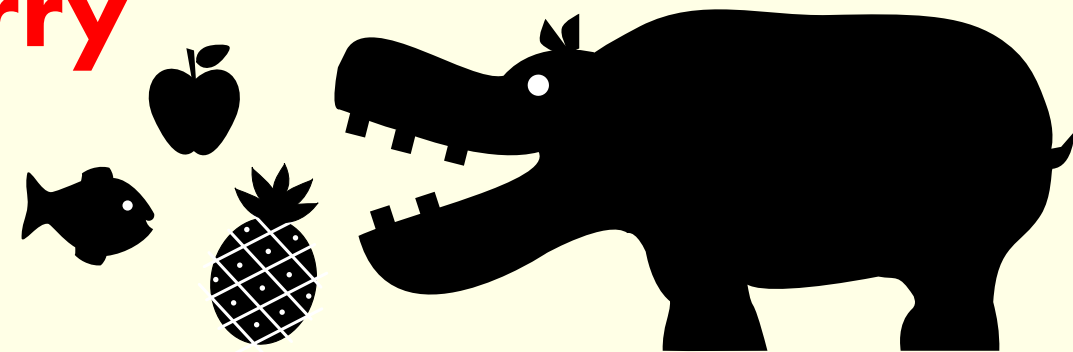
